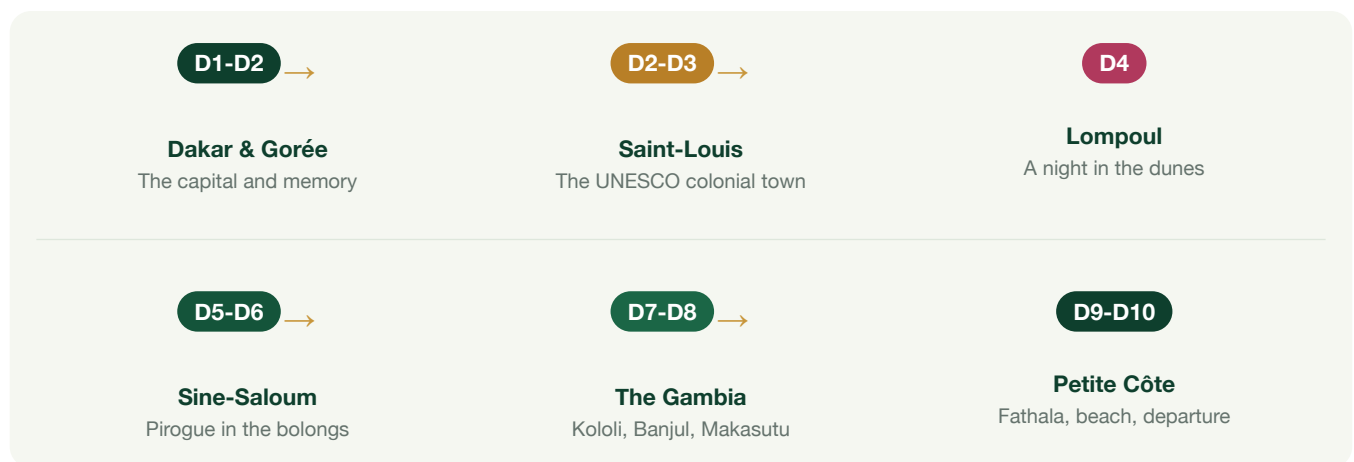

TEN DAYS, TWO COUNTRIES, ONE SMOOTH ROUTE

From Dakar to the Petite Côte beaches

A clear loop, with no pointless backtracking: Dakar and Gorée first, the drive up to colonial Saint-Louis, a night in the dunes of Lompoul, two days on the water in the Sine-Saloum delta, the crossing into The Gambia over the Senegambia bridge, then the return through the Fathala reserve and the Petite Côte. Each stop has its own colour, and the roads are planned so the journey stays a pleasure.

DAKAR, GORÉE, SAINT-LOUIS, THE DESERT

The north, from the capital to the dunes

DAKAR · ARRIVAL



Arrival in Dakar

We pick you up at the airport, drop the bags and take the pulse of the city: traffic, the smell of grilled food, the Atlantic close by and your first bearings with the team. No overdone welcome, just Dakar as it is, and a first evening to settle in.

GORÉE → SAINT-LOUIS



Gorée, then the road north

Gorée in the morning, with the time to understand the island rather than rush across it: the House of Slaves, the alleys, the memory. Then we take the northern road to Saint-Louis, the landscapes and the light shifting along the way.

SAINT-LOUIS



Saint-Louis, the colonial town

A day in Saint-Louis, the former capital and a UNESCO World Heritage site. We slow down: the Faidherbe bridge, colonial balconies, the Guet Ndar fishermen's quarter, music and street life. A town that tells its story slowly, between river and ocean.

LANGUE DE BARBARIE → LOMPOUL



From birds to dunes

A morning of river, sand and birds in the Langue de Barbarie park. Then south to the dunes of Lompoul: the scenery turns drier, more mineral, almost unreal. End of the day on the sand, sunset and dinner at the camp under the stars.

LOMPOUL → SINE-SALOUM

From dunes to delta

Waking up in the dunes, then a long but beautiful drive to the Sine-Saloum: villages, baobabs, stops along the way. On arrival the rhythm changes completely, the water, the mangroves, the silence of the delta. We drop the bags for two nights.

A pirogue day in the bolongs

A full day by pirogue in the bolongs. We move gently between mangroves, birds, islands and villages, with small scenes of life and a local lunch on the water. The nature heart of the trip, at your own pace.

BORDER → KOLOLI

Crossing into The Gambia

We cross into The Gambia over the Senegambia bridge, to keep a more reliable route than the ferry. A guided border crossing, then on to Kololi, on the Gambian coast: the mood, the English language, a different rhythm. We settle in for two nights.

THE GAMBIA

A Gambian day

A full day in The Gambia to really live it, not just pass through: a pirogue in the Makasutu mangrove, the sacred crocodiles of Kachikally, Banjul market, the beach and the Senegambia Strip. A second country with its own colour, its English, its music.

Why include The Gambia? Because the region makes more sense when you cross the borders. Banjul, the Senegambia roads and the return into Senegal give you a wider, rarer and more memorable sense of travel.

THE RETURN THROUGH NATURE

Back into Senegal

Back into Senegal over the northern border. Conditions permitting, a nature stop on the Fathala reserve side before reaching the Petite Côte. We finish the trip at Saly, by the sea: beach, pool, dinner facing the ocean. A proper wind-down.

PETITE CÔTE · DEPARTURE

Departure from the Petite Côte

A last morning by the sea, no heavy schedule: time to enjoy the beach or the pool before the transfer to Dakar airport (AIBD), depending on your flight times. We keep the day simple, just enough to say goodbye.

MEALS

Breakfast included · Airport transfer

What's included

- 9 nights in hotels, lodges and addresses with character, in a shared twin room.
- Breakfast every morning and several local meals chosen for the experience, not to tick a box.
- A local trip guide throughout, and Safari Sénégal support before departure.
- All scheduled transfers by private vehicle, with drivers used to the roads of Senegal and The Gambia.
- Pirogue in the Sine-Saloum, visits to Gorée, Saint-Louis, Lompoul, Banjul and the stops named in the itinerary.
- Entrance fees and activities scheduled in the programme, unless an option is clearly stated on site.
- Help with the Senegal-Gambia border formalities and on-the-ground coordination on departure day.
- A flexible deposit at booking, balance due 7 days before arrival.

What's not included

- International flights and the compulsory travel insurance.
- Visa, entry permit or any document required for your nationality for Senegal or The Gambia.
- Meals not mentioned, drinks, personal extras and tips.
- The single room supplement if you'd rather not share your room.
- Optional activities added on site, depending on the group's mood and the day's conditions.

Travelling solo? Welcome. The price is based on a shared twin room; you can request a single room (supplement \$490 ≈ €430) if you'd rather have your own space.

WHERE YOU SLEEP

Addresses chosen, not filled in

Six addresses for nine nights, each chosen for its location and character: a hushed villa in Dakar, a riverside boutique hotel in Saint-Louis, an oasis in the dunes, a lodge on the bolong, a Gambian institution feet-in-the-sand, and a resort of bungalows facing the sea.



NIGHT 1 · DAKAR, ALMADIES

The Palms Luxury Boutique Hotel · 4★

A hushed address tucked into the Almadies, designed like a private villa. Spacious, tastefully decorated rooms and suites, an outdoor pool framed by a tropical garden, a spa and a restaurant. The ideal refuge to recover from your flight and ease into the journey.

NIGHTS 2-3 · SAINT-LOUIS

Fly Fishes Hotel · 4★

Set on the banks of the Senegal River, facing the Langue de Barbarie and its sunsets. Themed rooms inspired by local traditions, a riverside terrace and a “farm-to-table” restaurant. An authentic, peaceful stop a stone’s throw from the UNESCO old town.

FLY NONSTOP FROM NEW YORK



Delta flies direct JFK → Dakar (DSS)

Every departure is timed around Delta's nonstop service: you land in Dakar on Friday morning, rested and ready for Day 1 — no exhausting connections, no lost day. Ten days later you fly home on Sunday. One easy flight there, one easy flight back.

Travelling from the United States? This trip is made for you. Small groups (never a packed coach), the same English-speaking local team with you from arrival to departure, hand-picked hotels with real comfort, and a gentle pace with time to rest between highlights. We handle the Senegal–Gambia border, the drivers and the logistics — you simply enjoy West Africa. Questions before you book? A real person answers on WhatsApp and by email, in English.

BOOKING

30% deposit

You secure your spot with a flexible deposit. The balance is due 7 days before arrival.

SINGLE ROOM

+ \$490 ≈ €430

A room of your own for all 9 nights, in the same addresses, if you'd rather have your space.

GUARANTEED DEPARTURE

From 2 travellers

If a departure isn't confirmed yet, we tell you clearly before you book your flights.

WHAT WE'RE OFTEN ASKED

The answers, straight

Is the departure guaranteed?

The trip is confirmed as soon as the minimum of 2 travellers is reached. If a departure isn't confirmed yet, we tell you clearly before you book your flights.

How many people travel together?

The group deliberately stays human-sized: enough to create good energy, small enough to keep flexibility on the roads, the meals and the visits.

I'm travelling solo, does it work?

Yes, solo travellers are welcome. The price is based on a shared twin room; you can request a single room if you'd rather have your own space.

How does payment work?

You book with a flexible deposit. The balance is due 7 days before arrival, which gives you more room than paying in full right away.

Is the pace intense?

This is a real overland trip: roads, early starts and full days. We also keep room to breathe, for markets, sunsets and the pauses that do you good.

Do I need a visa for The Gambia?

It depends on your passport. We send you a checklist before departure, but the final check of your documents remains your responsibility.

Is it safe?

You travel with a local team, drivers used to the route and support based in Dakar. We avoid needless improvisation and adapt if conditions change.

And the meals?

Breakfast every morning, plus several local lunches and dinners included at the key moments (desert, delta, Petite Côte). The rest is free, with the team's good addresses.

A 30% deposit, online or however suits you best. Immediate confirmation.

3 · Prepare your flight
